Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial

BY VIRTUE of the powers conferred by section 214 of the Local Government Act 1972 and of the Order made by the Secretary of State thereunder, WE, the PARISH COUNCIL for the Parish of BLOCKLEY in the County of GLOUCESTERSHIRE

(hereinafter called 'the Grantee') DO HEREBY GRANT unto the Grantee and his / her successors in title the exclusive right of burial in the grave space in STATION ROAD CEMETERY, BLOCKLEY, numbered on the plan of the said Cemetery made in pursuance of the said Act and Order TO HOLD the same to the Grantee and his / her successors in title for the period of 75 years from the date of this grant, for the purpose of burial and placing or maintaining a memorial.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the transaction hereby effected does not form part of a larger transaction or of a series of transactions in respect of which the amount or value or the aggregate amount or value of the consideration exceeds £60,000.
