1. To propose revised equipment for Churchill Close and Springfield play areas

Full discussion regarding the layout of Churchill Close and Springfield replacement equipment took place with design visuals. Consideration of the objectives of the Children and Young People Strategy was considered and the provision of space for young people.

RESOLVED the purchase of the replacement equipment for Churchill Close and Springfield to the value of £67,000 with the addition of metal feet on the climbing unit and agility trial, proposed KD, seconded ET, approved unanimously.
